Did You Know:

The *Triduum* celebrates the heart of Christian faith: Jesus' redemptive death and resurrection. The Triduum begins on Holy Thursday with the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper and washing of the feet. It continues through Good Friday with the Celebration of the Lord's Passion and the veneration of the cross. The Triduum culminates on Holy Saturday in the Easter Vigil, and concludes with evening prayer on Easter Sunday.

The celebration of Chrism Mass is on Tuesday, March 27 at 6 pm at the Cathedral of St. John Berchmans. Most Reverend Michael Duca will preside. The Holy Chrism, the Oil of the Sick and the Oil of the Catechumens will be blessed, and the priests will renew their commitment to priestly service at this Mass. A reception will follow Chrism Mass in the Parish Hall. Everyone in the diocese is invited to attend.
