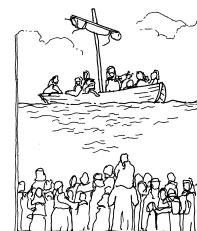

Summary: The Administrative Assistant for the pastoral suite performs a wide range of administrative and office support activities to facilitate the efficient operation of the departments for Worship, Vocation and Diaconate Formation.
